

# CHÂTEAU GUADET

SAINT ÉMILION GRAND CRU CLASSÉ - FRANCE



The Lignac family bought Château Guadet in 1844, in the heart of the village of Saint Émilion. Since then, seven generations have developed the domaine. The 5 hectares of vines, perched on the town's high limestone plateau, have been cultivated organically since 2008, and Biodyvin certification was obtained in 2015.
